**TO PLAY THE BESSEMER GEOCACHE DASH:**

Enter the co-ordinates for the geocaches listed on the back into a GPS tracking device.

OR TRY JUST USING THE CLUES

Find the container (geocache) hidden at or near the co-ordinates given.

PLEASE try not to damage the hiding spot or give the spot away to others.

Take only ONE drawing entry card per player from each geocache.

**REHIDE the container JUST AS YOU FOUND IT** – for the next player to find.

**DO NOT move the container.**

Fill out contact info on the back of each entry card.

*LET'S TALK TRAINS*

**This year we explore just a small bit of the railroads that were so prevalent and so vital to this area back in the day. Listed N to S, they are the Duluth South Shore & Atlantic RR, the Chicago & Northwestern RR, and the Soo RR. I highly recommend learning more on this topic, but for now, let me show you some cool spots.**

**#1 DSS&A Black River Rd crossing N46\* 30.568' W090\* 03.967'**

Who has seen these lights working? I will raise my hand.

**#2 DSS&A Black / Jackson Confluence N46\* 30.370' W089\* 59.795'**

How did the train get to the other side of the river? That's an adventure still on my to do list.

**#3 SOO Behind City Hall N46\* 28.635' W090\* 03.017'**

Ask about and support a brand-new trailhead park to be built here.

**#4 DSS&A Powderhorn Village N46\* 30.628' W090\* 05.697'**

The train ran through here long before the skiers.

**#5 DSS&A East of Black River Rd N46\* 30.597' W090\* 03.827'**

OH OH!! Here is a problem. You will know what it is when you get here.

**#6 C&NW Over powdermill Creek N46\* 28.525' W090\* 04.228'**

Looks awfully steep. Is there a rope?

**#7 DSS&A Over Powdermill Creek N46\* 30.520' W090\* 04.377'**

Keyword OVER, high over.

**#8 C&NW and Points East N46\* 28.782' W090\* 01.898'**

East of town, an easy find.

**#9 DSS&A Thru a ROCK N46\* 30.507' W090\* 04.248**

Amazing. I discovered this spot for the first time myself on my way to the next spot.

**#10 C&NW / SOO Crossing N46\* 28.563' W090\* 05.550'**

Hint: I used a motor to get to this one.

**#11 SOO 60' Turntable N46\* 28.447' W090\* 03.588'**

Always a wonder worth a free visit.

**#12 DSS&A west of Moore N46\* 30.693' W090\* 03.295'**
